Research Internship: Redesign of oil storage component of WER and design of an oil upgrading unit

Introduction

At our company Waste4ME BV we have developed a prototype system for waste reduction and energy generation at a local or small-scale using pyrolysis. One of the products of this system is pyrolysis oil. The oil is stored in small tanks and most of the components are operated manually. The pyrolysis oil does not have a standard composition and may require refining. We have an open internship position for a student to research the oil storage and refining.

Research existing oil upgrading and treatment techniques and design a storage and upgrading module to process, separate and store the pyrolysis oil.
